- Venue:** Deloraine Little Theatre
- Performances:** Friday evening, Saturday morning (if required), Saturday afternoon and Saturday evening.
- Adjudicator:** Marcus Bower
- Adjudication:** Immediately after each session.
- Awards:** Best Actor (male and female), Best Production, Best Director, Most Promising Actor or Director and others at the adjudicator's discretion.
- Entries close:** Tuesday, September 14th. 2010 with J. Kearon.
(Please observe this deadline as J. Kearon is heading to the mainland the next day.)
- Stage:** The main stage area is about 6m.wide and 4m.deep. There is an apron about 8m.wide and 2m.deep. There are three flats on each side of the main stage area and there are rear exits at each side. Steps lead down from the stage to the auditorium.
- Performing rights:** Presenting groups are responsible for obtaining performing rights as required. The Victorian Drama League has received a caution concerning groups in Festivals **performing titles without permission and unlicensed.**
